<p>1. WILDLIFE</p> <p>Mammals and Birds</p>	<p>New 5C Quintacel is not classified as '<i>Harmful to game and wildlife</i>'</p> <p>No risk management is necessary to protect wild mammals and birds. Chlormequat chloride, the active ingredient in New 5C Quintacel is of moderate toxicity to birds and mammals. The risk to wild mammals and birds grazing on treated crops is low.</p>
<p>2. BEES</p>	<p>No risk management necessary and there is no requirement to avoid application of the product when bees maybe foraging on flowering weeds.</p>
<p>3. NON TARGET INSECTS AND OTHER ARTHROPODS</p>	<p>No risk management necessary</p> <p>New 5C Quintacel poses a low risk to a range of arthropod species commonly found in and around treated fields.</p>
<p>4. AQUATIC LIFE</p>	<p>New 5C Quintacel is <i>harmful to aquatic organisms</i></p> <p>New 5C Quintacel is of low toxicity to fish and algae and of moderate toxicity to daphnia and certain aquatic higher plants such as duckweeds (<i>Lemna</i>).</p> <p><i>Do not contaminate surface waters or ditches with chemical or used container.</i></p> <p>No risk management necessary. When New 5C Quintacel is used according to the label instructions there will not be sufficient contamination of water to present a risk to aquatic life.</p> <p>Not categorised under the LERAP scheme.</p>

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<p>5. SOIL and GROUNDWATER</p> <p>Earthworms</p> <p>Soil Micro-organisms</p>	<p>New 5C Quintacel is of moderate persistence in the soil. Chlormequat chloride can be considered moderately mobile and it is unlikely that the substance will reach anaerobic soil layers. Use of New 5C Quintacel in accordance with the label presents a low risk to groundwater, therefore no risk management is necessary.</p> <p>New 5C Quintacel is of moderate toxicity to earthworms. New 5C Quintacel is unlikely to have any significant effects on earthworm populations. No risk management is necessary.</p> <p>No risk management necessary. No effects on soil microbial processes were found so the risk is considered low.</p>
<p>6. NON-TARGET PLANTS</p>	<p>When used according the product label, New 5C Quintacel should have no adverse effects on non-target plants. However as New 5C Quintacel is a plant growth regulator, care should be taken to avoid spray drift into non-target areas when applying close to field boundaries.</p>
